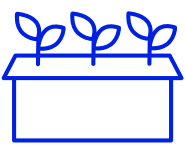
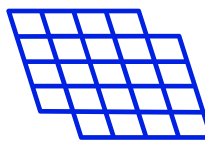
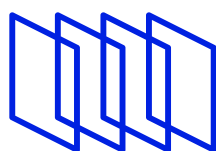
A landmark creative destination

The Gramophone Works is designed with sustainability at its core. As a reimagined heritage building, it holds a coveted BREEAM certification and was awarded the NLA Environmental Prize in 2021. Innovative features include an expressed timber structure that provides a carbon-neutral framework throughout the building's lifespan.
